MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU) BETWEEN DANNEX AYRTON STARWIN PLC (DAS PHARMA) AND

MPHARMA PHARMACEUTICAL LIMITED

Dannex Ayrton Starwin Plc (DAS Pharma), manufacturer and distributor of pharmaceutical products in Ghana have signed a Memorandum of Understanding with mPharma Pharmaceuticals Limited, a healthcare service provider to increase access to quality and low-cost medicines for Ghanaians.
